

**Here's a quick overview of all the clusters at St Paul's to get you started... pick a few and find out more...**

### **CORE**

It's a relationship thing. We are a youth cluster for 14-18's, gathering once a week in the centre of town, at the church offices. You don't want to miss the weekly challenge, the laughs & the chance to engage & talk about things of God that inspire us.

### **DESERT PLACE**

We are a group of people keen to be intentional about how we're living. We think that scripture is incredibly important so want to spend time immersing ourselves in the story & letting it shape our lives. We are a broad range of ages but mostly people between 18 & 60.

### **FAMILY FUN**

We want it to be about the whole family. Lots of us have energetic children in their middle years so we go to places like Cornwall Park, Parnell Baths. We also like to do things for other people in the community that help the kids connect with the world around them.

### **FOOD 4 THOUGHT**

We are mostly a group of young couples, and a few keen individuals, who love to meet together for a meal before tucking into hot topics and how to live true to our faith every day. Discussions range from the prophecies of Daniel, to Fair Trade, or how our careers should honour God. Praying for and encouraging each other is a focus.

### **HEAVEN'S EDGE**

As you would expect being from Out West we're pretty casual. The focus of our cluster is to connect with people in the local community. We want to create spaces and environments where we can process the messages we get at church; and continue to chew over and figure out how as a community we can put that into practice. We welcome all ages, couples and families.

### **INTERNATIONAL**

All ages and nationalities are welcome for worship followed by small group Bible studies – with one group specifically for students needing help with English. We also have English coaching (Fridays 3-5pm), a keyboard class (Saturdays 5-6:30pm) and social activities.

### **LUSTRE**

We are predominantly a family based cluster with pre-school children. Our cluster events are extremely informal & family focussed. We meet loosely in the Onehunga/Mt Eden area. It's all about relaxed family living & some occasional community service.

### **MILK & SOLIDS**

We're about spiritual food and family wholeness. We provide 'time out' where we can build supportive relationships and grow spiritually. We are passionate about enjoying good food and laughs with friends; and sharing adventures and simple pleasures with our kids.

### **ONE SMART FELLA**

We're a collection of people in our 20's and 30's who are about creating an open and honest community, centered on understanding and experiencing God while having fun in the process! We hope to provide an environment where people can take a step back from the pressures of life, feel safe enough to share what is going on in their lives and be prayed for.

### **POP**

POP—Pursuit of His Presence is a group of people from all stages of life, who are passionate about pursuing the presence of God.

### **RESTORE**

We are primarily about 3 things – living as people of the Spirit together, forming authentic community to do life together in, & committing to a lifestyle of social justice. We have a wide mix of people from students through to people in their 60s, including quite a few young kids.

### **SONIC**

We bridge life and faith through new experiences together. We like to do adventurous things that cater to all levels of confidence. We are a bunch of people that aim to support and impact each other and others around us.

### **SUNDAES ON MONDAYS**

Our cluster aims to create a place of belonging, a place to debate doubts around life and faith and a place to get a good feed. We have the audacity to hope we can change the world - in a big or small way. And most of all we want to get closer to Jesus. We are in our 20s and 30s and meet in a small group every week for dinner, dessert and hearty discussion.

### **ZEST**

We're a slightly older age group but very diverse in terms of age, experience and profession. Our emphasis is to welcome people who are trying to find their way at St Paul's. Many of us are parents.
